Current Covid-19 Information

COVID 19 or COVID 19 Investigations due to symptoms:

- Incubation of Covid-19 is 1-14 days but mostly 3-7 days (average 5 days)
- You can contract it from asymptomatic carriers.

To review: Symptoms of COVID 19

- Most will get a mild respiratory illness
- 89% fever, 68% cough; 38% fatigue; 34% sputum production (thick mucous when coughing); 19% shortness of breath; 14% sore throat; 14% headache
- Uncommonly, there will be diarrhea and vomiting
- Sore throat, runny nose, and muscle aches are uncommon, so it is not typical of the flu or a cold

If you have been asked to self-isolate due to contact with someone with COVID-19, or have the illness, contact your care provider immediately.
